When the Congress created the National Labor Relations Board, it conferred on the Board no authority to supplant Congress itself in the law-making field. Congress set the labor-policy of the Government in the Wagner Act, the Taff-Hartley Act and the Landrum-Griffin Act, and the Board's only job was to administer labor-management affairs under those lays. Now the Industrial Relations Committee of like National Association of Manufacturers has complianted to the Congress that the NLRB is ignoring the laws that Congress passed and is writing its own laws as cases come before it. for judgment.

In the same resolution, the NAM-group asked the President to adopt a policy of timuling-his actions and those of Executive—Department heads in labor-management disputes to actions the law authorizes.

In the resolution, the NAM committee didn't ask changes in the law itself—except one. That is to take the authority to judge cases from the NLRB and give it to the Federal Courts, which have a habit of observing the law in their decisions.
