Mobile Home Laws Told

On September 16, 1969, the City of Florence adopted an ordinance regulating the location of automobile trailers prescribing the penalties for and mobile homes; the plumbing and wiring required, and For the purpose of this ordinance, an "automobile trailer" or "trailer" or "mobile home" means any vehicle or structure so designed and will permit occupancy as sleeping quarters for one or more persons, or the conduct of any business or profession, occupation or trade, and so designed that it is, or may be mounted on wheels and used as a conveyance on highways of city streets, propelled or drawn by its own or other motive power, except a device used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

business occupancy must be submitted to the city building official. When such permits are granted, the use cannot exceed 12 months. Renewal permits must be requested at the end of each 12 months period. Trailers and mobile homes used for business are authorized only in zoning districts B-1, I-1, and I-2.

In addition, the city zoning ordinance, adopted in May 1968, prohibits the parking of recreation type equipment such as boat trailers, travel trailers, pickup campers or coaches on automotive vehicles, motorized dwellings, tent trailers and the like, for more than 24 hours in any residential district except in a carport, enclosed building or to the rear of, or alongside a building away from the street.

Trailers of any kind or type without current license plates can not be parked or stored in any residential district other than in completely enclosed buildings.

A trailer owners are urged to comply with these ordinances in order to make Florence a safe and beautiful place to live. Violation of these ordinances is considered a misdemeanor and can result in the issuance of a citation.
