

Scottsboro Rape Case Defendant Is In Trouble Again

DETROIT. (AP)—Haywood Patterson, once sentenced to death in Alabama's Scottsboro rape case in the early 1930's, was in jail here today as a suspect in a Detroit barroom slaying.

The 37 year old Negro gave himself up yesterday after learning police were hunting for him in connection with the fatal stabbing of Willie Mitchell, 27, also a Negro, last Saturday.

He was questioned and booked without charge "for investigation of murder," homicide detectives said. Detective Lt. Gerald Walters said a witness told officers that Patterson stabbed Mitchell in a fight following an argument.

Patterson escaped from Kilby prison at Montgomery, Ala., in July, 1946, while serving a 75 year sentence for rape. He was captured last day.

last June in Detroit but Michigan Gov. G. Mennen Williams refused to order his extradition to Alabama. He had been working for a Detroit construction company.

Patterson and eight other Negroes were arrested at Paint Rock, Ala., March 25, 1931, and charged with raping two white women on a freight train. The charge against one of the nine was dropped when it was found that he was only 13 years old.

The other eight were sentenced to death but the U. S. Supreme Court ordered new trials. After six years, four were sentenced for rape, a fifth for stabbing a deputy sheriff, and the rest were released.

The others given sentences have all been paroled. Following his escape, Patterson wrote a book called "Scottsboro Boy," in which he claimed the charge against him was a frame-up. He also condemned conditions in Alabama prisons.

Fireworks Present Problem In Filming Two Weeks With Love

Staging an authentic bang-up helicopter Fourth of July celebration in the tradition of the early 1900's, when pop invariably sang his handkerchief mishatches, something of a headache to the property man on M.G.M.'s new Technicolor musical, "Two Weeks With Love."

This picture was specially selected by the management of Muscle Shoals Theatres as ideal holiday family entertainment. It comes to the Tusculum on Saturday and Sunday, to the Shoals on Sunday and Christmas Day, and then to the Colbert on Tuesday and Wednesday.

A canvas of fireworks manufacturing plants revealed some surprising information. Some were such items as giant crackers, pinwheels, Roman candles, Torpedoes and Silver Fountains, Buzz Bombs, V-Rockets, Buzz Bugs, Bazookas and flame Throwers.

Since the new picture, starring Jane Powell, Ricardo Montalban, Louis Calhern and Ann Harding, was filmed in color, the props as well as the actors required tests. Individual specimens of the prophecies were set off one dark night on the studio's Lot III, with the result that a report immediately or-

culated among the neighborhood's small fry to the effect that an invasion from Mars had been attempted. However, it was determined that fireworks look and smell pretty much the same today as they did in the pre safe-and-sane era, and since the frightening appellations associated with World War II were removed from the wrappers they were found suitable for the fireworks sequence of "Two Weeks With Love." The one complicated item proved to be an exhibition piece depicting the American flag in 1900, the period of the story, the flag was short three stars, Oklahoma, New Mexico and Arizona having not then been admitted into the Union. A special flag with forty-five stars was created, just in case someone with a gift for hair-trigger calculations decided to count.

While most props for pictures set in the nostalgic period of the turn of the century have become familiar to modern-day motion picture fans, "Two Weeks With Love" really goes to town on relics salvaged from grandma's attic and even grandpa's fireworks, the props include such heirlooms as silver-handled toothbrushes, occupational shaving mugs, paintmex fans, a carload of drug-store equipment, corks, mail boxes, brass beds, hand instruments of the old handspan period and a surry with the fringe on top.
