Lauderdale Revenue Measure

Status Of Bill Uncertain In Legislature

MONTGOMERY (Special) - House Local Legislation Committee today approved a bill changing Lauderdale County from a second class to a first class county following a public hearing.

Sponsored by Representative N. E. Bart, it was approved by the Lauderdale and already approved by the Senate under the sponsorship of Senator Milton W. Grisham.

The measure would put Lauderdale County government back on the same basis on which it operated before a 1953 act was passed amid a storm of controversy.

Representative N. E. Bart (R-Bart) introduced the measure in its present form. Bart wants the bill to provide for submission of the measure to a vote of the people of Lauderdale County for approval or disapproval before the measure is passed.

The measure was set up by a County Board of Revenue and abolishing the old Court of County Commissioners.

Among Lauderdale Countyans present for Tuesday afternoon session were: J. B. Longshore, who initiated the change two years ago, and former Rep. Baker, who was defeated in his race for Lauderdale County in 1952.

Rep. Hallam, at Tuesday afternoon session, announced that he would restore the old Court of County Commissioners.

The committee went into executive session Tuesday afternoon before deciding to approve the bill.

WASHINGTON (AP)—Diplomatic officials look for an intensification of the cold war as a result of the government shakeup in Moscow.

A major objective of Soviet foreign policy in the next few weeks is expected to be the blocking of West German rearmament under agreements negotiated in Moscow.

The new combination of Premier Nikolai Bulganin, Foreign Minister V. M. Molotov and Communist Party Secretary Nikita S. Khrushchev is believed likely to use threats of force and intimidation—a whole line of tough talk and perhaps tough action—to try to frighten the French and Germans away from final action.

Under ex-Premier Georgi Malenkov the Kremlin had followed a basically different strategy of trying to reduce international tensions, halt the flow of European arms and security and thereby persuade the French and German peoples, if not their governments, that the rearming of Germany was unnecessary.
