Automatic Weapons Battalion Alerted

BIRMINGHAM (AP)— Brig Gen. Walter J. Hanna, Birmingham commanding general, Alabama National Guard troops Saturday, announced the 46th Anti-Aircraft Automatic Weapons Battalion has been alerted for induction into the Army Jan. 23.

Hanna is deputy commander of the 31st (Dixie) Division, composed of Alabama and Mississippi units. He was announced week before last that the Dixie was being called to active duty Jan. 18.

The 46th Battalion is commanded by Lt. Col. Ralph E. Glasgow, Birmingham. It is composed of five batteries, including Battalion Headquarters and Headquarters Battery at Talladega, commanded by Capt. W. C. Humphries.

Other units are Battery A, Shalston commanded by Capt. Charles Simpson; Battery B, Aniston, Capt. N. B. Head; Battery C, North, Capt. E. B. Fowler; and Battery D, Jasper, Capt. R. T. Fuller.

Total strength of the battalion was not disclosed.

Col. Glasgow went to Montgomery Saturday to confer with Major Gen. James S. Solito, State Adjutant General, over induction of the unit into federal service.

NEW CREW DECORATIONS

PRAGUE (AP)— New decorations for model soldiers and air cadets were introduced in the Czechoslovak army Jan. 1 by order of the commander-in-chief, President Klement Gottwald.

The decorations, called "badges of honor" are to show the Bohemian army's status as a modern fighting force. They are for those "having accomplished outstanding achievements in military or political training and having fulfilled their military duties in exemplary fashion."
