Coup That Failed

WASHINGTON is still talking about the tense, dramatic battle in the house of representatives in which a southern Democratic-Republican coalition attempted to overturn the house rules committee, grab control of the Truman administration program and again set up a totalitarian dictatorship in which seven men at their own caprice could act with or without legislation from action by the other 428 members of that body.

The coup failed by a vote of 185 to 195, but President Truman himself had entered the fray throwing the weight of his entire administration into the coalition to hold the lines against the coalition.

The southern delegations were pressured as never before by the Dixiecrats. They used all the intolerance engendered by the civil rights program. They played upon the desire of the Republican leadership to stop cold the Truman Fair Deal program. The administration sent out wires, phone calls, used every pressure to bring back house members who were absent.

The tip-off came when a Republican motion to adjourn was defeated. It would have delayed a vote until over the week-end. Then with a packed gallery and a house quiet with tension the vote came. The Republican leadership could not hold many GOP congressmen in line particularly in the New England states. Truman won. Here's the background of this fight which may have far reaching effects on this congress. It cost a long session or failure of this session to accomplish anything for the nation.

Fight for Freedom

Lesson for February 19, 1936.

THERE ARE TWO KINDS of problems with living things. One is the kind of problem caused by its growing too fast; the other is the problem caused by not growing fast enough. The early church had mostly the first kind of problem, at any rate it was taking in a lot of members whom the older Christians found strange. At first not all Christians had been Jews; no one thought of anything else. But in Antioch, as we have seen, and even more so at the church spread westward around the edge of the Mediterranean, the Christian churches were filling up with non-Jewish members. Just as they are today.

It is no secret that in the Masonic order there are 33 degrees. It is not possible for a new member to be taken right into the 33rd degree the first night. Everybody has to go through the lower degrees which are called the Blue Lodge. Now many persons in that early church thought of the Jewish faith as a sort of Christian Blue Lodge.

All the very earliest Christians had been members of that lodge; why should every one else be the same? So when Paul and Barnabas came back from that historic missionary tour of Cyprus and points north, telling about the large number of non-Jewish Christians, these old-style Christians shook their heads.

Paul was by-passing the Blue Lodge. He was trying on members who had not gone through the proper preliminaries, the first degrees.

Powerful Group

For many years the rules committee of the house was the most powerful in that body. It still is. It acts as sort of a traffic cop for legislation. It has 12 members—eight Democrats and four Republicans. Under house procedure all bills considered by their committee are sent to the rules committee for handling down for action.

Under the old procedure the committee could hold these bills indefinitely. Only a petition signed by a majority of the house membership could pry loose a bill.

At the last session of the 81st congress when this same group of congressmen tried to take over control of the committee from its chairman, Congressman Adolph J. Sabath of Illinois, a house vote overrode him to clip the power of the committee and place a maximum of 21 days on the time the committee could hold a bill. After that time, the chairman of any other committee could call down a bill from the rules committee for house action.

Choose Their Time

The rebel leadership on the committee, headed by Congressman Eugene Cox of Georgia, picked a time three days before the controversial Fair Employment Practices bill was due for handing down.

He corralled two other southern Congressmen Howard J. Smith of Virginia and William M. Colmer of Mississippi, and had little difficulty in persuading the four Republican members to join them in a coalition taking operation of the committee out of the hands of its chairman.

Seeking to beat the deadline on the FEPC bill, they went to the house floor with a majority motion of their committee asking the old dictatorial power of the committee be invoked once again. It meant the death of all civil rights legislation and even of all the Fair Deal legislation to which the seven men were opposed.

Republicans joining in the coalition bloc were the GOP ranking member, Leo E. Allen of Illinois, chairman of the committee in the 80th congress; Clarence J. Brown of Ohio; and W. Wadsworth of New York and Christian Herter of Massachusetts. They prevailed upon the house GOP leader, J. P. Martin, former speaker, and Charles Halleck, former GOP floor leader, to go along.

Civil Rights Lost

There is every reason to believe that the civil rights program of President Truman will be lost in congress. There is no effective weapon yet devised against the senate filibuster. But the rest of the Fair Deal program was also at stake and the President had everything to gain and nothing to lose, since the southerners are opposed to most of his program anyway.
