These dealers' certificates, also good for 120 days, carry the dollar value of the purchase orders. They are turned over to regular suppliers or CCC when dealers buy replacement grain.

Issuance of purchase orders ended Feb. 15. Dealers who accept approved purchase orders after that date will have the 120-day period to convert them into dealers' certificates.

"Feed dealers who wait too long to have the 120-day expiration dates to transfer certificates may not have time to make the transfer. They may lose out on the dollar value of the certificates when they buy replacement grain from CCC," Mosley emphasized.

Dallas CSS office has sold about 1,750,000 bushels of grain to date. West and southeast feed dealers since last summer when the program got underway. The sale included 5,200,229 bushels grain sorghum, 2,065,458 bushels oats and 86,131 bushels corn.
