Miss Katherine Forney, teacher of handicapped children, spoke at the weekly meeting Monday evening of the Florence Lions Club.

Miss Forney told the club the seven reactions of people toward a handicapped child—curiosity, pity, over-solicitousness, mild dislike, rejection, fear, sympathy and understanding. She said understanding is what they are trying to teach in this school.

She also stated that this school is the first of this type to be put in a teachers college in Alabama, and is sponsored and helped by the Muscle Shoals Service League. Its program is to train more teachers to work with handicapped children.

Miss Forney explained how the school tries to help the children and how they are taught to read and to count. She said the school consisted of children between the ages of 5 to 18.
