CAFES, HOTELS GOOD MARKETS FOR PRODUCTS
Are you overlooking local markets for your farm products?
API Extension Marketing Specialists ask every Alabama farmer to consider the possibilities of selling fresh vegetables, fruits, poultry, dairy, and livestock products to cafes, and hotel dining rooms.
Many such establishments have indicated that they would like to buy fresh farm products locally. Such

markets will be regular purchasers, if they can get what they want when they need it.
Any farmer interested in steady local marketing should list all the nearby food establishments and contact them at once for possibilities for later sales.
SELECT HOME FREEZERS CAREFULLY
The Alabama farm family buying a home freezer should remember that large quantities of meat or other foods should be processed first at a plant equipped for such services. Very small volumes of warm food can be quick-frozen in the home freezer, says an API bulletin on marketing, but large volumes will effect the temperatures.
Freezers vary in size from two to 50 cubic feet. Buy from a dependable dealer, particularly one who can service and repair the freezer should this be necessary.
A different way to serve beets is to slice them thin and top with a mixture of French dressing and mustard.

CUT SHARP TEETH OF NEWBORN PIG
A newborn pig needs a bit of dental work before he gets his first meal. An API Extension bulletin advises farmers to cut the eight sharp teeth, commonly known as black teeth, of young pigs immediately after birth. If these teeth are temporary and of little use to the suckling pig.
"These teeth," continues the bulletin, "if not cut, may puncture or bruise the sow's udder. Then she will not let her pigs suck. Consequently she will dry up sooner than she should and the pigs will not receive proper nourishment for growth and health. Cutting these teeth therefore contributes to a good pig crop."
Good tools to use in cutting the teeth are a pair of sidecutting pliers or nippers. Cut close but do not injure the gums of the tiny pig.
Protect your winter clothing during the coming summer months by placing them in a tight trunk, chest or wooden box and scattering one pound of either flake naphthalen or paradichlorobenzene between the fold of the clothes.

New Designations Given For Motor Oil Grades
Those who buy new tractors, cars and trucks should consult the three following classified grades to find out if the oil recommended is defined by one of the new designations for motor oils, say Iowa State college engineers. These new grades have been established by American Petroleum Institute to help the purchaser know what type oil he is buying. The three designations are:
Regular motor oil: This is an oil with no chemicals added. It is generally suitable for use in internal combustion engines under moderate operating conditions. This includes most passenger cars and trucks as well as farm tractors.
Premium oil: This term designates an oil which has been stabilized by chemicals. Oils of this type are recommended for internal combustion engines where operating conditions are such that the regular motor oil will not give satisfactory service. Motor oil users will find that this oil gives superior service in passenger cars, trucks and tractors.

Hollow Reeds and Logs Were First Fines Used
Although pipe is one of the most indispensable of mankind, no one knows its origin. Beginning it may have started as a reed or a log with a hole in it.
The earliest of hollowed reeds or logs used for piping is that of the ancient Egyptians. There was also hollowed piping in the Tigris and Euphrates valleys, and perhaps even in the Nile valley, in good enough condition to make a positive identification. It is known that the Egyptians used copper pipe in 3500 B. C. and the Chinese used hollow bamboo pipes at about the same time. In pipe gas as much as 100 yards from a gas well to a city or a power plant is common.
Some time later, in what is now a part of Syria, several of the palaces and temples had water pipe made of baked clay not unlike the tile drain pipes used today. Clay piping was used with a cement type of mortar to carry water only from roof-outs on the roofs to the lofts below.
