"The Lawless Is Exploration Into Minority Problem

In recent years Hollywood's unwritten but longstanding taboo on so-called "problem" pictures have been slowly lifted. Once it was considered hazardous to produce a movie that had a controversial theme and there was a noticeable reluctance on the part of most film makers to commit what they regarded as financial harakiri.

But with the production of such smash successes as "Gentleman's Agreement" and "Crossfire," which dealt with anti-Semitism, and "Home of the Brave," "Lost Boundaries" and "Toussaint," which focused on the Negro problem, there came the realization that there is a tremendous audience for pictures that expose and intelligently examine the ills that beset our society.

Paramount's "The Lawless," which comes here next week, is the latest Hollywood film to explore the problems of a minority group in the United States. It is a slashing, no-punches-pulled indictment of discrimination practiced against Mexican-Americans in California, and a blistering denunciation of mob violence.

Produced by William Pine and directed by Thomas Hayes, "The Lawless" unfortunately falls into that category of not by accident either, for the producers fully realized that any movie no matter how vital its entertainment values if it is to win favorable recognition.

An original screen play by Geoffrey Homes, "The Lawless" is the first story of an American boy of Mexican parents who, though innocent of any crime, is charged with criminal assault and hunted down like an animal by a lynch-bent mob, simply because his skin is not white enough.

To gain authentic small town atmosphere, the picture was filmed on location in Marysville, California, a few miles north of Sacramento in the center of the fruit and vegetable-growing area. More than 2,000 local citizens, including the mayor who was given a one-line speech, were used as extras in almost all of the scenes and they performed like vocalists, according to Pine and Thomas.

Macdonald Carey stars in the film as a new teacher, whose friends and the terror-stricken boys, played by screen heavyweights Lalo Solari and Paul Douglas, portrays a renegade.

"The Lawless" will show here next week on the following schedule: Ritz-Sunday and Monday Strand-Tuesday and Wednesday Princess-Wednesday and Thursday.
