### No Fatalities In Lauderdale During First Quarter

Lauderdale County was one of three counties in the State that reported no traffic fatalities in the first quarter of this year or last year, according to Bill Lyster, director of public safety.

Other North Alabama counties records are as follows: Colbert County had one fatality this year and one last year over the same period of time. Franklin County had three fatalities last year and eight this year. Lawrence did not have any last year, but reported one fatality this year. Limestone reported six this year and had only four fatalities last year.

The quarter is from January 1 to March 31.
